**MOTION FOR ADVERSARY PRELIMINARY HEARING**

Defendant, Brianna Williams, by and through the undersigned attorney, the Public Defender for the Fourth Judicial Circuit of Florida, moves this Honorable Court, pursuant to Rule 3.133(b), Florida Rules of Criminal Procedure, for an adversary preliminary hearing in this cause. As grounds, Defendant respectfully states:

1. On November 12 2019, Defendant was arrested by an agent of the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office and booked into the Duval County Jail.

2. Defendant has not been charged by Information or Indictment within 21 days from the date of Defendant's arrest or service of the capias upon Defendant.

3. Rule 3.133(b), Florida Rules of Criminal Procedure, provides that a defendant who is not charged in an information or indictment within 21 days from the date of his arrest or service of the capias upon him shall have a right to an adversary preliminary hearing on any felony charge then pending against him. Said rule further provides that the subsequent filing of an information or indictment shall not eliminate a defendant's entitlement to this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, Defendant respectfully requests this Honorable Court conduct an adversary preliminary hearing in this cause.
